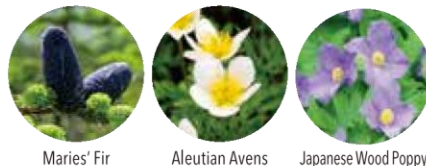

The Kenashi Paradise Line winds through the changing elevations of Kenashitai. This is a popular mountain climbing route that even beginners can enjoy.

This is a water activity in which you float along the quiet waves as you paddle. With some practice, children can enjoy this activity as well.



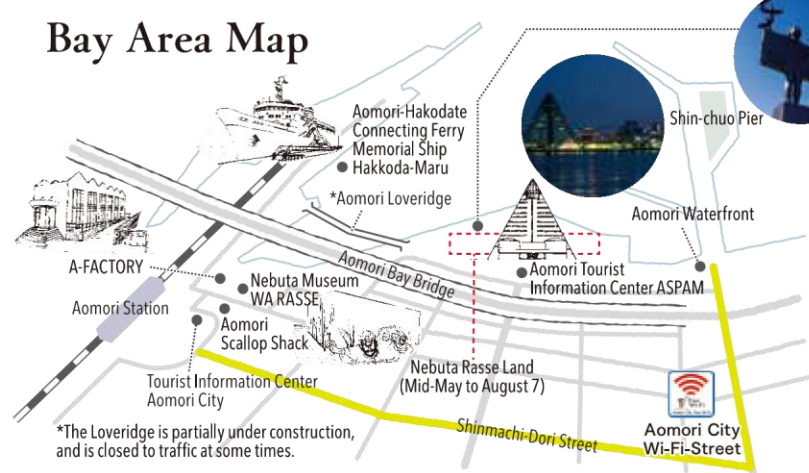


Aomori Nebuta Festival (August 2nd - 7th)

This is Japan's preeminent fire festival. At this festival, 22 Nebuta Floats, each weighing approximately four tons, wind their way through town, accompanied by dancers and music.

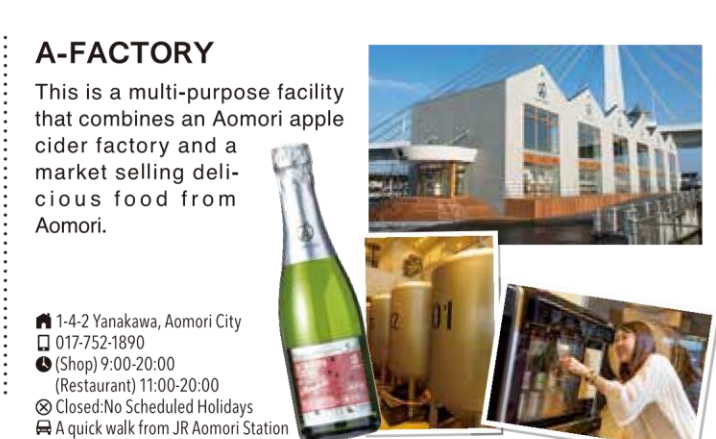

Historic Komakino Site

Characteristic of this site is its Late Jomon Period stone circle, among the largest in Japan. The site is thought to be a place where festivals and rituals were carried out. A large number of artifacts have been discovered here.

Hakkoda Mountains Incident
This tragedy occurred in 1902, and it was even made into a movie. This facility exhibits documents related to the worst disaster to occur in the history of the mountains of Japan. The facility conveys the severity of the Hakkoda Mountains in winter to the present.

Aomori Dog

The three-dimensional artwork Aomori Dog by Yoshimoto Nara stands over 8.5m tall. Its integration into the museum building is a characteristic feature of this artwork.



Artist Yoshitomo Nara is a native of Aomori Prefecture. His permanent exhibition room displays works specially selected from a collection of over 170 pieces.



Aomori Museum of Art

This museum permanently exhibits world-famous artworks by Marc Chagall and other artists. Also in its permanent exhibition are works by artists with connections to Aomori Prefecture such as Shiko Munakata and Yoshitomo Nara. Another fascinating aspect of the museum is the beauty of the building's architecture.

About the Aleko Works The Aleko Hall displays large-scale background artwork painted by Marc Chagall, one of the greatest painters of the 20th century.

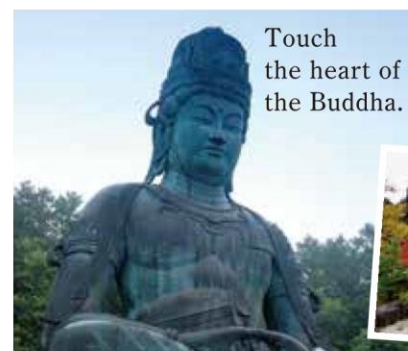

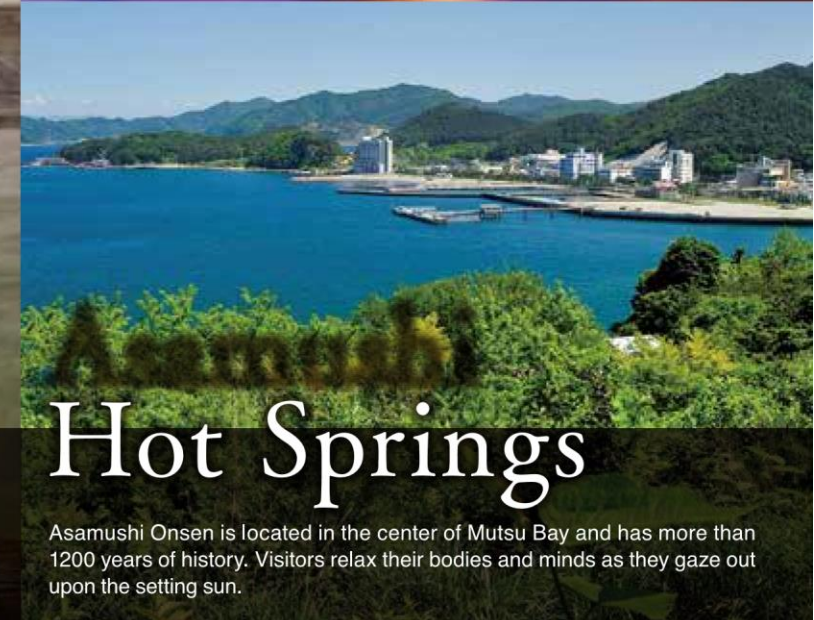


REST AT ABUNDANT HOT SPRINGS



Hakkoda Hot Springs

Hakkoda is known for its many gushing hot springs. The harsh climate created abundant hot springs that have healed visitors with their warmth since ages past.



Hot Springs

Asamushi Onsen is located in the center of Mutsu Bay and has more than 1200 years of history. Visitors relax their bodies and minds as they gaze out upon the setting sun.

The "thousand person" hiba cypress bath at Sukayu Onsen has four different kinds of hot springs. It is also a mixed-gender bath, which is unusual within Japan. Women can wear yuami bathing suits in the bath. In addition, there are women-only time periods set between 08:00-09:00 and 20:00-21:00.

Smaller, gender-segregated baths are also available. These smaller baths are drawn from a different source than the "thousand person" bath, but the water has the same cloudy, sulfurous properties.

Asamushi Aquarium

Asamushi Aquarium is the northernmost aquarium on Honshu Island, exhibiting 10,000 sea creatures from approximately 300 species. The aquarium boasts impressive dolphin performances and activities that allow visitors to come into contact with the animals.

This 15 meter-long glass tunnel recreates the sea of Mutsu Bay. Here visitors can see scallops being cultivated and observe the marine life of Mutsu Bay.

Kaiyakimiso
 This is the most famous local food of the Tsugaru area. In this dish a scallop shell is used in place of a cooking pan. In the shell dashi broth, scallops, mushrooms, onions and other ingredients are simmered in miso paste and topped with an egg.



Sea Cucumber
 Sea cucumbers caught in Mutsu Bay are the definitive taste of winter in Aomori. Sea cucumber is characterized by a fleshy and crunchy taste. It is an absolute must for New Year cuisine.



Local Aomori Sake (Denshu, Kikuizumi)
 Aomori is famous for its water and high-quality brewer's rice, and is therefore well-suited to sake brewing. Techniques handed down from the past create high-quality sake famous across Japan.

Spring
Togekuri Crab
 This is a small horsehair crab that can be caught in Mutsu Bay. They taste superb with a sweet, delicate meat and rich crab butter.



Summer
Acorn Barnacles
 Acorn barnacles are a luxurious delicacy known for a flavor reminiscent of the seashore. The taste is similar to crab butter or shrimp.



Autumn
Flounder
 Both farm-raised and wild caught Aomori flounder are considered delicacies. The crunchy fins are especially delicious.



Winter
Cod Milt
 Ultra-fresh cod milt is best experienced raw. The rich umami flavor melts in your mouth.

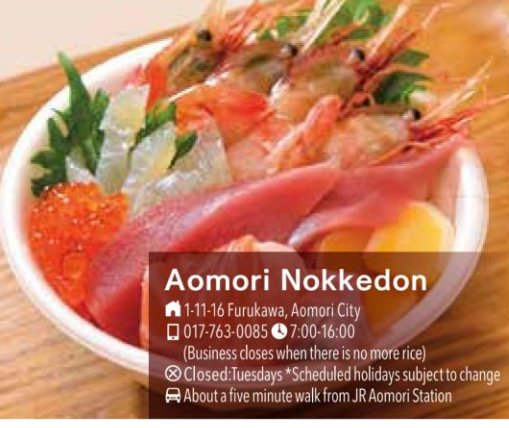


Thick-Style Dried Sardine Ramen

Aomori Apple Pie
 Lots of simmered apples in a crispy pie crust.

Aomori Apples
 Aomori Prefecture produces more apples than any other prefecture in Japan. Each year approximately 50 varieties of apples are cultivated.

Apple Juice and Cider
 There are many varieties of drinks that use Aomori's famous apples.



Aomori Apple Chips
 These apple chips are crunchy with a sweet and sour aroma.



Apple Tea
 The fragrance of apples fills the air when hot water is poured on this tea.



Blackcurrant Pie
 In this blackcurrant pie, the blackcurrants are simmered with apples. This gives the apples the coloration of the blackcurrants.



Aomori Blackcurrants
 Aomori produces more blackcurrants than anywhere else in Japan. Blackcurrants are rich in vitamins and anthocyanin. They are said to be good for the skin and overall beauty, and are attracting attention as a health food.

Blackcurrant Gelato
 The acidity of the blackcurrants gives this gelato a sharp taste.

Blackcurrant Cake
 This cake has a rich mousse with lots of Aomori blackcurrants.



TAPUKO The GAMA
 This is a new dressing that combines mayonnaise with garlic grown in Takko, Aomori Prefecture. Each time a shipment comes in, it immediately sells out. Use it as a dip for vegetable sticks or fried potatoes!
