




















# Collection Days for Household Refuse

Please obey the rules and dispose of refuse correctly

Category	Collection Day (Excluding National Holidays)	Items and Disposal
Combustibles	Weekly Tuesdays and Fridays	Items 40cm (16in) and smaller are disposed of in specified rubbish bags. Food waste, waste paper, plastics which are <u>NOT</u> marked with the  symbol, cloth, leather, rubber items etc.    
	Weekly Fridays	Items sized 40cm-60cm (16in-24in) are disposed of <u>without</u> rubbish bags. Plastic kerosene tanks, singular (unstacked) clothing boxes, portable coolers, futons etc.     
Non-combustibles	Monthly 1st and 3rd Thursday	Glass, porcelain, earthenware, metals etc. are disposed of in transparent bags. ○ Gas canisters/spray cans, batteries, fluorescent tubes, lighters, mercury thermometers etc. are disposed of in the <b>orange receptacle</b> provided.   
Empty cans PET bottles Glass bottles	Monthly 2nd and 4th Thursday	○ Empty cans are disposed of in the green cloth receptacle provided. ○ PET bottles are disposed of in the blue cloth receptacle or the green net provided. ○ Glass bottles are disposed of in the orange receptacle provided   
Used paper Beer bottles 1.8litre bottles (brown/green)	Monthly 2nd and 4th Monday	○ Used paper (paper cartons, cardboard, newspapers, magazines, etc.) are tied with paper twine or disposed of in paper bags. ○ Beer bottles and 1.8 litre bottles (transparent brown or green) are disposed of in the orange receptacle provided.  
Other plastics	Weekly Mondays	Disposed of in the blue net provided. Food trays, egg cartons, sweets packets etc. marked with the  symbol.
