① Oversized Rubbish

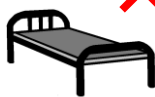
(Items larger than 60cm. Also applies to oil stoves that are smaller than 60cm.)



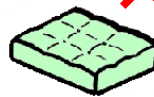
Oil stoves

Refrigerators



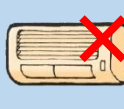

① Request collection by the Oversized Rubbish Reception Centre (☎017-718-1184)

Fees apply. Bi-monthly collection days occur on fixed dates. Apply as early as possible.

① Bring items to Aomori City Rubbish Disposal Plant
Some items will be directed to the nearby landfill (fees apply)

Do not dispose of large amounts of rubbish all at once

If too much rubbish (combustibles, non-combustibles etc. not including oversized rubbish) is disposed of at once, the disposal area will not have room for other people's rubbish! Please dispose of your rubbish a little at a time.
